



To all of our neighbors,

During challenging times, one thing is constant: despite the emergency, whatever the need, our community takes care of one another. Thank you for partnering with us, for your financial support, for your words of encouragement, and for asking how you can help.

Due to the increased risk of COVID19, Note in the Pocket will be closed beginning on Monday, March 23.

We will be ready to resume operations as soon as possible. The health and safety of our staff, volunteers, and community is of utmost importance.

During this time we will not be accepting donations at our main location or our off-site drop off locations. We will still encourage folks to use this time to clean out closets, but request that they bring clothing to us once we are back to our normal operating process.

We recommend sorting donations into the following categories and labeling the outside of the bag:

1. Spring/summer school appropriate clothing
2. Fall/winter school appropriate clothing
3. High quality non-school appropriate clothing (items that could be consigned to raise funds for clothing we need to purchase)
4. Remission or recycle clothing (items that have stains, tears or rips, used socks or underwear)
5. Place all shoes in a separate bag from clothing

Note in the Pocket's focus remains on how we can best serve our community. For now, that is through following the recommendations made by the CDC by doing our part to keep our community safe.
